The title of the piece (published in 1961) refers to the Anglican service of Morning Prayer, which traditionally pulls together readings from psalmody, scripture, and musical selections, but does not feature Communion.





#### Diferencias sobre la Gallarda Milanesa

Antonio de Cabezón (1510-66)

Spanish Renaissance composer Antonio de Cabezón was hugely talented as a performer and improviser, even though he was blind from birth. He worked as a court musician for Isabella of Portugal, who was married to Charles V of the Holy Roman Empire. This piece is a set of variations on the Milanese Galliard, which was a type of dance, the tune of which would have been well-known to Cabezón's audiences. This music, along with many other works, was published posthumously by Antonio's son Hernando.
