

The Druid Hills Billys

ALL: With God's help we will so order our lives after the example of Christ, that Camille, surrounded by steadfast love, may be established in the faith, and confirmed and strengthened in the way that leads to life eternal.

A blessing from Camille's grandfather, The Reverend Dr. R. Kevin LaGree:

"...baptism does not confer on us a status that marks us off from everybody else. To be able to say, 'I'm baptized' is not to claim an extra dignity, let alone a sort of privilege that keeps you separate from and superior to the rest of the human race, but to claim a new level of solidarity with other people. It is to accept that to be a Christian is to be affected – you might even say contaminated – by the mess of humanity. This is very paradoxical. Baptism is a ceremony in which we are washed, cleansed and re-created. It is also a ceremony in which we are pushed into the middle of a human situation that may hurt us, and that will not leave us untouched or unsullied. And the gathering of baptized people is therefore not a convocation of those who are privileged, elite and separate, but of those who have accepted what it means to be in the heart of a needy, contaminated, messy world." – Rowan Williams, *Being Christian: Baptism, Bible, Eucharist, Prayer* (2014)
