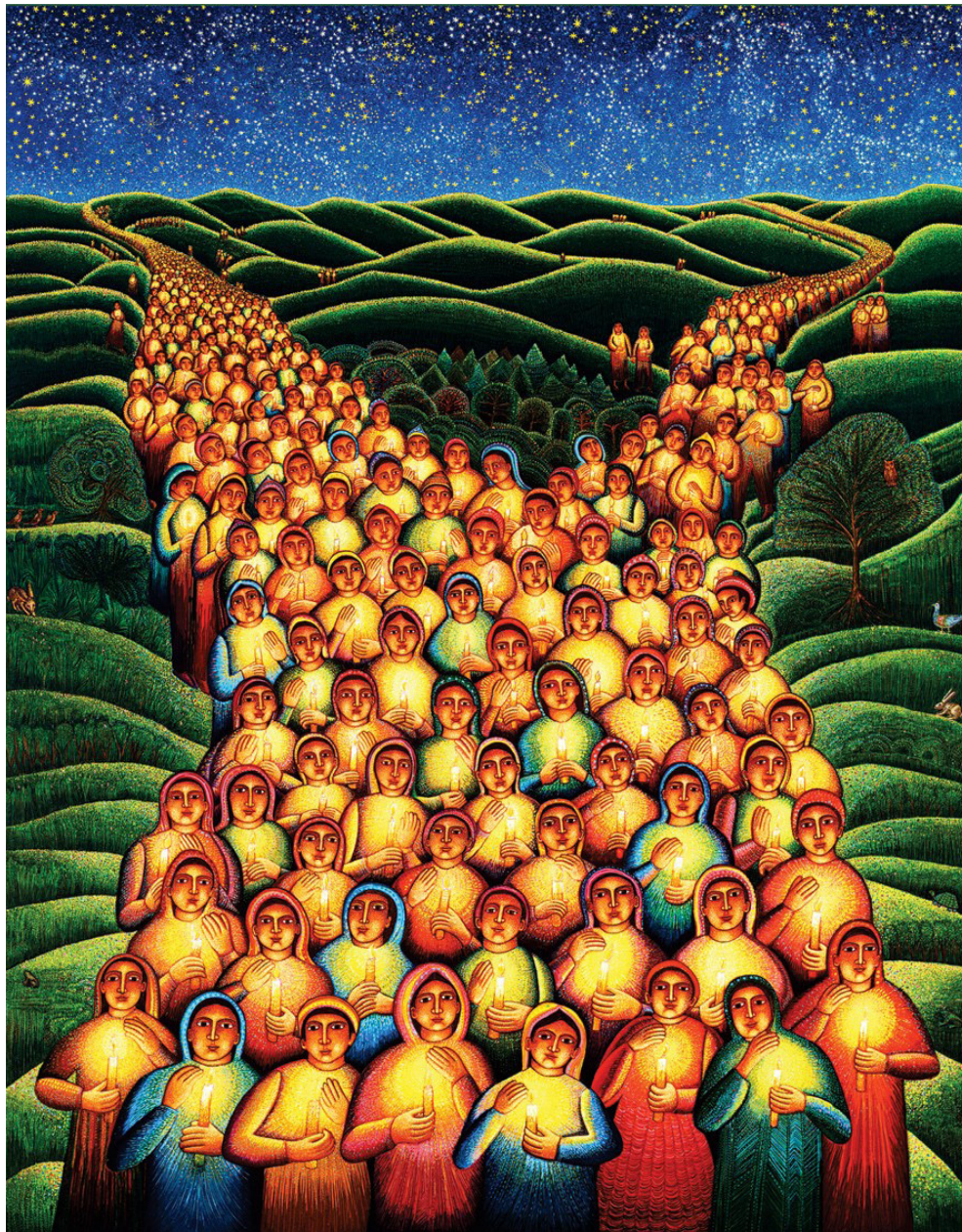



John S. Dixon (b. 1957)

John Dixon was born in the UK and studied at Oxford and Harvard Universities, focusing on business, rather than music. However, music has always remained a present force in his life. In the late 1980s, he moved to Norfolk, VA and remains Organist and Composer-in-Residence at Providence Presbyterian Church in Virginia Beach. True to its title, Moto Perpetuo (“perpetual motion”) maintains an almost constant moving line of music, whether in the right hand, left hand, or pedals.
