

Elizabeth Stirling (1819-95)

Stirling was a organ recitalist and composer in England at a time when women did not commonly hold leadership positions in churches. She was known for exceptional pedal-playing, and she studied at the Royal Academy of Music, where many other accomplished British organists and composer studied (and continue to study). This piece is gentle and lilting and shows off the warmer and more subtle sounds of the organ.



Marching to Zion

Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958)

English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams published this meditation on Hyfrydol (the tune upon which today's Offertory is based) in his collection, *Three Preludes on Welsh Hymn Tunes* in 1920. Vaughan Williams' harmonic language is full of parallel fourths and fifths, perhaps referring back to the medieval practice of organum or to traditional folk songs.
